AGAIN!!! SLOW DOWN -SPEED LIMIT IS ONLY 10 MILES

The Front Office has received reports of individuals SPEEDING through the resort. We have many residences that walk every day through the resort. Not only do we have people walking but we have children playing and walking home from the school bus. It would be a tragedy if someone was hurt from not following the rules that are clearly posted.



We have a fragile sewer system. Please only use toilet paper that is rated for septic systems. Do not flush, disposal wipes, baby wipes, wet wipes, even the wipes that state they are flushable (it appears that only a very small percent of these products break down). Also never flush feminine hygiene products, grease, chemicals paints, paint thinners or varnishes into the sewer. Recently we have had several sewer issues that were caused by improper disposal of items. This effects the whole village with additional cost and sanitation issues.

Toilet paper made from recycled paper is recommended.

However, because the manufacture of fluffy soft toilet tissue requires the use of *new wood* fibers from trees, we recommend that consumers purchase and use toilet tissue made of recycled paper. Not because soft toilet tissue hurts our septic system, but because ultra-soft tissue brands mean we're flushing our forests down the drain unnecessarily.

Look for toilet tissue that is made entirely or at least in part from recycled paper. Here is a small list of toilet tissue brands that are considered "most green": **Green Forest**, **365**, **April soft**, **Earth Friendly**, **Fiesta & Fiesta Green**, **Natural Value**, **Seventh Generation**, and **Trader Joe's**.

If we all work together, it should help prolong the life of our sewer system.

Item number 14 States: No vehicle shall be worked on, that is no repairs are to be performed in the parking area unless there is an EMERGENCY.

Any changes to the outside of the unit must be approved by the Board of Directors. An Architecture Review Form must be filled out and submitted for approval. Examples of items that must be approved are, color of front door, adding landscaping to the common element, and gutters, just to name a few.
