Pet Rules

All pet(s), (including cats) must be registered with the Association.

Each pet must comply with the Lake County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 4, Article II, and have a current license and must have an up to date shot record from your veterinarian.

Each pet will receive a tag from the Association, which should be clearly visible when the animal is out for a walk.

If any pet(s) exhibits aggressive and /or vicious behavior, the Board will send one (1) violation letter to the owner of the animal. If a second incident with the animal occurs, the Lake County Animal Control will be contacted. The Board reserves the right to permanently remove the animal.

At all times when pet(s) are not inside the unit, the pet(s) shall be kept on a leash.

All solid pet(s) waste must be picked up and disposed of properly.

Pet(s) will not be left unattended outside or on the lanai.

Pet(s) will not create excessive or constant noise to become a nuisance to others.

Photo of pet(s) and proof of Lake County Animal license must be provided within ten (10) business days once pet is maintained within any unit.
